
OSAGE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT PROCEDURES FOR COUNTY BUILDINGS DUE TO COVID-19




Effective October 12, 2020, the Osage County Buildings will be requiring the public and staff to wear a mask or face covering upon entering the buildings to access the Osage County offices and departments. This is a preventative measure designed to reduce the spread of the coronavirus.
