ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMIT ON COUNTY ROADS AND OTHER ROADWAYS NOT OTHERWISE POSTED

Ordinance No. 08-23

WHEREAS, it is the public policy of the Osage County Commission to ensure the safety of the residences of the County of Osage by enacting various ordinances intended to promote public safety.

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the safety of the public when traveling in Osage County it is necessary to implement an ordinance limiting the speed of vehicles on various roadways that run throughout the county.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 304.010 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, the County Commission is granted the authority to set a speed limit upon county roadways.

WHEREAS, the County Commission hereby sets the speed limit on all county maintained roadways at the speed of 35 miles per hour.

WHEREAS, said ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement agency having jurisdiction upon any of the roadways impacted by this ordinance.

WHEREAS, a violation of this ordinance shall carry a penalty of a fine of no more than \$500.00.
