### **Departmental Reports:**

The Sheriff Bonham reported that he is considering increasing the number of prisoners held in the County Jail by 5 to provide additional revenue for GR01. He estimates that total cost including staff, feeding, medical etc. will run up to \$108,000 but the increased revenue should provide about \$27,000 to GR01. These prisoners would be from other counties and the Highway Patrol which are better payers than State reimbursement.

He said that they are beginning work on next year's budget. He said the recirculating pump seems to have corrected the problems as they no longer get complaints about cold water in the showers.

County Clerk Steele reported that his staff would be provided training on canvassing of voters by the Secretary of State's Administrator of MCVR, Anne Steele on October 11, 2017 in the morning.

Clerk Steele discussed the installation of equipment to make the side door of the Administration Building handicap accessible. He reported that it should cost approximately \$2500 which is already included in the Budget.


