Meetings:

Travis Massman: returned to Commission to continue discussion on process to legalize ATV use on County roadways. Cited Maries County as example of legal recreational use of ATVs. Linn Lions Club is also in support of making ATV use on County roadways legal, so that their ATV events can be legal when it occurs, according to Sheriff Bonham. Mr. Massman stated that potential good for County could compensate for any negative effects, including generate revenue, increase safety awareness, and host county trash cleanup efforts. Also brought up that ATV events with local Lions chapters gives all proceeds back to community. Presiding Commissioner Dudenhoeffer had County statutes of ATV use printed off and Commission referred to them throughout meeting. A maximum of \$15.00 is all that can be charged to ATV drivers if legalization goes through. Presiding Commissioner Dudenhoeffer seeks to confer with Maries County while at a MRPC meeting evening of September 13, 2018. Presiding Commissioner-elect Darryl Griffin suggested a public hearing for matter would be appropriate. Commission will continue to consider options.

Department Reports:

County Clerk: Tax Levy and reduction Report was provided to the Commissioners by County Clerk Steele.

Health Dept: Submitted detailed monthly reports for July and August 2018, specially mentioning that July had new high of tick-borne illness investigations. As of September, one positive flu case in Osage County.

Road & Bridge: Asphalt rejuvenation project has all materials staged and ready at RB shed in ^{Linn}~~Bonnets Mill~~. While working on CR 706 on September 12, 2018, theft of trailer and supplies took place. Foreman Kempker purchased spill barrel kits from Surplus Properties in Jefferson City, Missouri. Meant to purchase two spill barrels to have on hand in event of emergency or unexpected oil spill, but will have to wait for more shipments to acquire second barrel.

- Bid advertisement period completed. Sheriff waiting to hear back from City of Linn for variance report in order to begin building fence for equipment corral.
- Prisoner count is up compared to last year.


