A motion to approve the agenda for August 9, 2018, and meeting minutes for August 2, 2018, was made by Commissioner Kliethermes, seconded by Commissioner Glavin, carried with three ayes in roll call vote.

Meetings:

Jeff Banderet with ^{GREAT} Three Rivers Engineering, updated commissioners on analysis of closed Holterman Bridge on CR 608. Bridge needs moderately minor repairs done to the bearing pad. Due to size of bridge, minimum amount to fix deficiencies would start at approximately \$75,000. No guarantee yet that State Inspector's office may clear bridge to be re-opened, if county commits funds to repairing bridge's primary issues.

Department Reports:

Sheriff:

Monthly report submitted. Noted that Sheriff's Department has received approximately \$350,000 in donations in past 6 months. Set-up of deputy offices completed. Jail received donation of 10 mattresses and some other furniture items. Jail now able to accommodate to full capacity, if/when needed. New computers arrived that were donated by federal government. Single bid on fence for new equipment corral behind courthouse—better bidding advertising needed, Sheriff Bonham recommended to confer with local newspaper staff to do so. Arrests up by about 30%. State Technical College of Missouri partnering with Sheriff's Department to do all maintenance and upkeep on vehicle equipment. Junior Deputy Program to resume August 22, 2018.

Other:

US Board of Geographic Names: Request to change name of county creek from Housgen Creek to Huesgen Branch. Commission's approval pending.

Public Service Commission Osage Commissioners not required to take any action on changes applied by Union Electric.

Meramec Regional Planning Commission submitted annual membership bill of \$5,190, for population of 10,380.

Nuclear Exercises: two disaster response exercises; one rehearsed, one graded, assigned for July 9, 2019, and August 13, 2019.

Public Comments:

Commissioners communicated with Tipton, Missouri, for similar bridge closing, repair, and approval situation. Closed bridge on Osage County Road 531 in need of raising/leveling on west side; need approval from Federal highway authorities, according to engineers inquiring with state, about delayed approval for bridge's repairs.
